A Few Logistics

Signing In. Please sign your child in and out everyday on the Arrival and Departure sheets in the main hallway. If you are adding a day or an Aftercare afternoon, please let us know verbally and in writing using the A LA CARTE sign in sheet.

Weekly Flow. There is fluid movement among the classrooms throughout the week. This allows students to explore activities and work in other rooms, and interact with new friends.

Aftercare. The River Song Aftercare Program runs from 3:15pm to 5:30pm with Miss Sierra.

Snacks. Please read the daily snack menu every day, and let your classroom teacher know if there are any allergies or diet restrictions. We will accommodate with alternative snacks as necessary.

Parent Handbook. Copies will be available soon. Please take time to read through the handbook for important information.

Observations. It typically takes students several weeks to "normalize" to a new environment. We ask that if you are interested in spending time at the school, feel free to join us for our daily morning circle at 9:00 am, or volunteer to come early to share a story at the end of our school day.
